ORDER

Upon hearing counsel for the claimant and the first defendant in person (the second defendant not appearing)

And upon the first defendant's informing the court that he does not pursue his claim to a reverter under the Literary and Scientific Institutions Act 1854 to the building ("the Building") at 51, East Street, Bridport, Dorset known as the Bridport Literary and Scientific Institution

And the court being satisfied that it is appropriate to adjourn this claim for about 6 months so that the Bridport Area Development Trust ("BADT") has a reasonable time to put itself into a position where the court could, if it thought fit, properly make an order vesting the Building in the BADT to be held upon the trusts and for the purposes of the BADT

It is ordered that:

1. The claim be adjourned

2. The claimant shall in due course restore the claim for further hearing before the master, such hearing to be in about 6 months from today's date

3. Either the claimant or the second defendant shall be at liberty to restore the claim for further hearing before the master at an earlier date.
